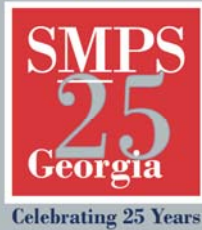

Board Positions (Sept. 1 – Aug. 31)

President

Principal officer of the Chapter exercising general oversight of its affairs and Officers

President-Elect

Assists the President in overseeing the Board and serves as an additional resource for all positions and committees, and stands ready to fill in for the President in his/her absence

Past President

Remains on the board in a capacity of advisor and to provide continuity to the new Board of Directors (not an elected position)

Treasurer

Ultimately responsible for the fiscal management and financial integrity of the Chapter

Secretary

Chronicler for the Chapter ensuring minutes are taken, recorded and distributed at all Board and Executive Committee meetings, and sends formal correspondence for the Chapter

Director-At-Large – Communications

Plan and implement Chapter brand recognition through various communication activities including PR, newsletters, website, etc.

Director-At-Large – Membership

Plan and implement recruitment and retention of membership through various activities including new member orientation, Ambassador Program, member handbook, year end networking event, etc.

Director-At-Large – Programs

Plan and implement business development luncheon programs and networking time

Director-At-Large – Education

Plan and implement educational universities and forums, manage CPSM study groups, and manage student scholarship program

Director-At-Large – Chapter Development

A strategic advisory position charged with planning, developing, and/or directing initiatives that contribute to the overall success and growth of the Chapter
